## SEPTIC SYSTEM REPLACEMENT PROGRAM

The State of New York has allocated money to replacing deficient septic tanks on specific bodies of water in the County of Saint Lawrence.

If you own a house within 250 feet of Cranberry Lake, Star Lake, or almost any river in the Adirondacks (see link below for specifics) and your septic tank is too small, breaking down, or otherwise deficient you may be eligible for funds through the New York Septic System Replacement fund.

If you believe you are eligible please call or email our office, and we will get you the appropriate paperwork. Our goal is to protect the waterways of Saint Lawrence County.
